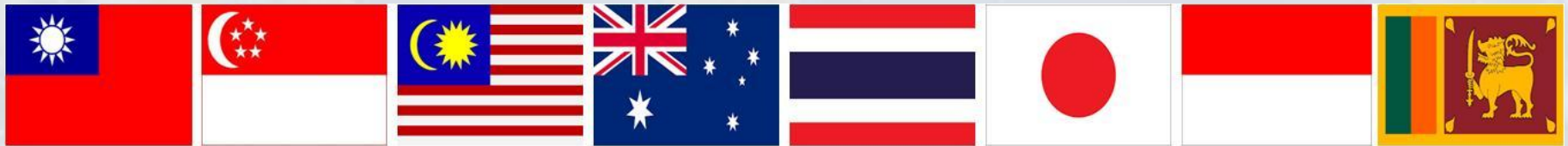

Tournament Rules

1. Amended rules (New Rules) will be applied for this competition (for U18 group only):
 - Possession time 25 second shot clock with 15 second exclusion time.
 - 25m x 20m pool size
 - No.4 ball will be used
 - Six players one of which must be a goal keeper with five substitutes, as per FINA rules.
 - Some teams might have over 11 players coming with the teams for experience in an international tournament. The committee will allow teams to submit up to 13 players for each game. However, No. 11 and/or No.13 (up to submitted name lists in each game) must be the second goalie. Those players (not over 3 players) who are not involved in that game are allowed to be sitting behind the substitute players, so they can get a feeling with the team but they must remain seated at all times. **Note:** Submitted team lists must be done least 30 mins prior to the commencement of the game and handed to the table secretary/controller.
 - All other rules will be as for FINA events.
2. **Open Competition:** Current FINA rules i.e. 13 players per team, 30sec shot clock/20sec exclusion time, 30m x 20m pool for men, 25m x 20m pool for women, etc will apply for Open Men and Women groups.
3. Point system for the first round is Win = 3 points, Draw = 2 points, Loss = 1 point, and Forfeit = 0 points
4. Game times: 1st round, play offs, and 5th – 6th place, will be played 6 mins actual time (stop/start) for 4 quarters with 2 minutes intervals between quarters, **without timeouts**.
5. Only games no. 34, 35, 36, 37, 38 and 39 will be played with FINA official rules, 8 mins actual time for each quarter, 1 Time Out per team for each quarter, etc. Games that require a decision will go straight to penalties after the completion of the game, if scores are tied.
6. Pool side Team Presentations are only required for games no. 35, 37, and 39

Tournament Rules

7. If teams have over 13 players (maximum of 15 players per team) and need to change their players list, please submit new team lists to the table secretary, 30 mins prior to the commencement of the game.
8. Teams must be presented at the pool, one hour prior to the commencement of their game.
9. The warm up pool will be the first priority for teams which will be playing in the next game.
10. Teams must be ready for starting the game as soon as the previous game is finished.
11. Any team which doesn't have its own caps must inform and request caps at the officials table, 30 minutes prior to starting the game
12. A referee's T-shirt will be provided. Referees can wear short white pants and white, open footwear because it might be a bit hot. Referees please bring a wide brimmed hat or cap.
13. When deciding final group standings, FINA rules will be applied.
14. Any player excluded for brutality will automatically miss the next game with substitution after 4 minutes for that game. However, players who commit brutality could be excluded for the rest of the Tournament, subject to the Judiciary Tribunal's decision. Players have a right of appeal to the Judiciary Tribunal.
15. Two counts of brutality will result in the player(s) missing the rest of the Tournament.
16. Games might commence earlier or later than shown in the schedule without any notice. Please arrive at the pool before the start time in the schedule, as per rule no.8.
17. Teams must be responsible for finger nails and sunscreen requirements. Referees will check before the start of the Tournament and could recheck during the game. Non compliance could result in exclusion.
18. The Sky Train is in construction around the campus and a traffic jam may cause the late arrival at the pool. Please make sure that teams allow enough time to arrive at the pool, as per rule no. 8.
